Mexico climate change goals update

Unconditional emissions reductions by **2030**: **35%** of emissions and **51%** of black carbon.

40 measures estimated total annual reduction of **88.9 MtCO₂e** by 2030.



- 50% of new light-duty vehicles by 2030 will be zero-emissions.
- NOM 163 (fuel efficiency standard for light vehicles) under discussion.



- Mexico's REDD+ National Strategy 2017-2030 (ENAREDD+) to reach 0% net deforestation by 2030



- 40 GW of clean energy capacity
- Substitution of high-carbon fuels for natural gas in high-efficiency power plants.



- 3.5 MtCO₂e annual reductions by 2030
- Large industrial sources regulated by the Mexican ETS
